Follow-up activity

Play a mime game with the class. You need a selection of simple verb phrases that the children will know and be able to mime (e.g. *play football, read a book, talk on the phone, play the piano*, etc.). Invite a group of five or six children to the front of the class and tell them to each take a card. Explain that they will have ten seconds to mime their action. When you say *Stop!* they must freeze. Have the other children put their hands up to guess what they were doing: e.g. *Doha was reading a book, Nabeel was playing football*. Invite a new group of children to the front and continue.
