Follow-up activity

Play a drawing game with the children. Prepare enough sentence cards for each pair of children to have one. The sentences should all be present continuous: e.g. *The king is swimming*.

Each pair of children needs some scrap paper. Give a card to one of the children in each pair. They must draw a picture to illustrate the sentence, and their partner must guess the sentence.

When they have finished, they pass the card to the next pair. The child who guessed last time draws. Keep passing the cards until they are finished.
