Follow-up activity

Play a memory game with the children. Demonstrate the game with a small group of children. Start by saying: e.g. *In my bedroom, I've got a desk.* The first child says: e.g. *She's got a desk, and I've got a chair.* Each child then says what the others have said (using *She's / He's got*) and adds something new.

Once the children understand the game, divide the class into groups of six to eight to play the game.
