Follow-up activity

Tell the children you are thinking of an animal. Give them information about the animal one sentence at a time, and ask them to guess what it is. For example, *It lives in the mountains. / It eats goats. / It runs very fast.* (Snow leopard). Then tell the children to think of an animal and write three sentences. Have them play the same guessing game in pairs. Change partners two or three times.
