Follow-up activity

Before the lesson, make a set of simple verb cards with verb phrases written on them: e.g. brush my teeth, play football, phone a friend, climb a tree; and a set of adverb cards: e.g. slowly, quickly, loudly, quietly, nicely, carefully, sadly. Ask one child to come and take one verb card and one adverb card and mime the action in the manner on the adverb card. The class must guess the verb and adverb. Then put the children into pairs and give each pair one verb card and one adverb card. One child then mimes the action while the other guesses. They pass the cards to the next pair and continue the game, taking turns to mime and guess.
