Follow-up activity

Play *Simon Says* with the children, using the action verbs from the unit. Explain that if you say *Simon says* first: e.g. *Simon says jump!* then the children do the action. If you do not say: *Simon says*, e.g. *Jump!* the children do not move. Anyone who makes a mistake is out of the game. Once the children have the idea, they can play it in pairs or small groups, taking turns to give the instructions.
